**Supporting:** Student is a baptized Catholic, family is a registered member of St. Luke Parish, active in parish life including support of parish activities, e.g.: fiesta/Family Fun Day, attendance at Mass, uses Sunday envelopes and contributes a minimum of \$380.00 per year.

**Non-Supporting/Non-Catholic:** Family is not registered at St. Luke Parish, does not attend Mass regularly/does not meet contribution requirement. Student is not a baptized Catholic.

**Payment:** Tuition is broken into two categories: supporting and non-supporting/ non-Catholic. Tuition is due on the fifth of the month. There are various payment plans available: annual, semi-annual, 10-month, or 12-month plan.

#### **FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS**

**THE SCHOOL YEAR:** St. Luke Catholic School operates on a 180 day school calendar. The school year typically begins in mid-August and finishes at the beginning of June.

**THE SCHOOL DAY:** The school day for all students Grades TK-8 is 7:55 AM—3:00 PM Tuesday through Friday. We have early dismissal on Monday at 2:00 PM for Faculty Meetings.

**ST. LUKE BEFORE AND AFTER SCHOOL CARE:** School Care is provided to St. Luke Catholic School students. It is staffed by school employees from 7:00 AM to 6:00 PM each school day. We offer a wide variety of indoor and outdoor activities that are designed to provide a number of choices to meet the needs of the children. The program is designed to provide a quality, low-cost, well-supervised, caring environment.

**<u>UNIFORMS</u>**: Students are required to wear uniforms. Uniforms are available through CKW in Temple City.

**<u>VOLUNTARY INVOLVEMENT PROGRAM (VIP) HOURS:</u>** As primary educators of their children, St. Luke parents are a vital part of the school community. Since parent enthusiasm and energy are of great importance to the school, each family is requested to make a commitment to contribute 30 hours of volunteer service to the school each year. The school offers many ways to earn these hours.

#### **ADMISSIONS CRITERIA:**

- 1. New parents and student/s will be given a tour, as well as an opportunity to meet the principal.
- 2. Applications are reviewed by the Administrative Staff using the following guidelines:
  - a. Registered member of St. Luke Parish
  - b. Mass Attendance
  - c. Use Sunday Envelopes and contribute a minimum of **\$380.00** per year January to December. (In January, you will be asked to pick up your receipt from the Parish Office, and submit it to the school, in order to qualify as a supporting member of the parish.)
- 3. Service to the school is mandatory for all. There are NO exceptions.
- \*Students will be tested once accepted, in order to see where they are and move them forward on their learning continuum.

St. Luke Catholic School accepts all applications. Preference is given to siblings of currently enrolled students and to Catholic children from St. Luke Parish families who actively participate in the life of the parish and contribute at least \$380 per year through the use of Sunday envelopes. Test score evaluation, class size, curriculum provisions, and assurance of parental cooperation are also considered in the acceptance of new students.

Second preference is given to Catholic children from families active in other parishes. Non-practicing or non-Catholic children are accepted as students, when classroom space is available.

The Principal makes the final decisions on admission of students.
