We are working in collaboration with the Archdiocese of Los Angeles to make this transition as seamless as possible, while continuing to emphasize that learning is maintained to the highest degree possible.

St. Luke Catholic School faculty is preparing for Distance Learning. The teachers will be/have sent out emails to invite the students to Google Classroom. We will be utilizing a combination of Google Classroom, our school website, emails, textbook work, packets, zoom meetings, teacher recorded video, etc. to make our time beneficial for our students.

Monday, March 16, 2020- the students will come to school with their parent/guardian between the hours of 8:00 AM-10:00 AM. At this time, the students will pick up all their textbooks and supplies and take them home with them. This will enable the students to work remotely from home. In addition, the teachers will have any packets ready for them to take home with them. In addition, I ask that you please take the time to fill-out the survey that was sent to you.

We will be conducting classes via Zoom, as well as teacher recordings. The teachers will be teaching during the regular school day. Assignments will be posted on Google Classroom and all students will be held accountable for their coursework. There will be deadlines for submissions, etc. As we will be a closed campus, until further notice, the teachers will have an open-door virtual policy. All teachers will be available for questions/clarification on lectures/assignments. For immediate response, teachers will be available for questions/clarifications during the following times: 7:30-8:00 AM for all teachers and 3:00-3:30 PM for all teachers, except Mrs. Bocanegra.

Mrs. Bocanegra's will be 7:30-8:00 AM and 12:00-12:30 PM.
